The Optometric Glaucoma Society (OGS) is pleased to announce the call for applications to attend the **5th Annual OGS Glaucoma Resident Meeting to be held in Ft. Worth, TX from February 3-5, 2012**. Any resident who has started their ASCO/ACOE accredited residency program in the summer of 2011(2011-2012 Residency year) is eligible to apply. The OGS has received an unrestricted educational grant to support travel and accommodations for one resident from each school or college of optometry.

If a school or college of optometry has several residency programs, more than one resident may apply and an OGS committee will select the individual who will attend. It is important that all residents affiliated with a school or college may apply; not just "in-house" residents. As long as the particular site where the resident is obtaining training is accredited by ACOE, they are eligible to attend. The committee is looking for candidates who demonstrate a significant interest in glaucoma and glaucoma related research.

The deadline for application submission is September 15, 2011. Residents should obtain approval from their resident director before applying. Applications are available at the OGS website, www.optometricglaucomasociety.org. Please let me know if you have any questions.
